

## Iconic Maps of Marin: 1860-1925



**Historian, Author & Map Archivist Dewey Livingston** provides an in-depth look at three iconic maps of Marin County made in 1860, 1873 and 1892, and introduces us to a little-known Marin map series made by County Surveyor John C. Oglesby in 1925. The maps illustrate Marin growing over a span of 65 years from sparsely populated to a bustling rural county, yet also show how little changed during those years relative to the land development that followed World War II.
